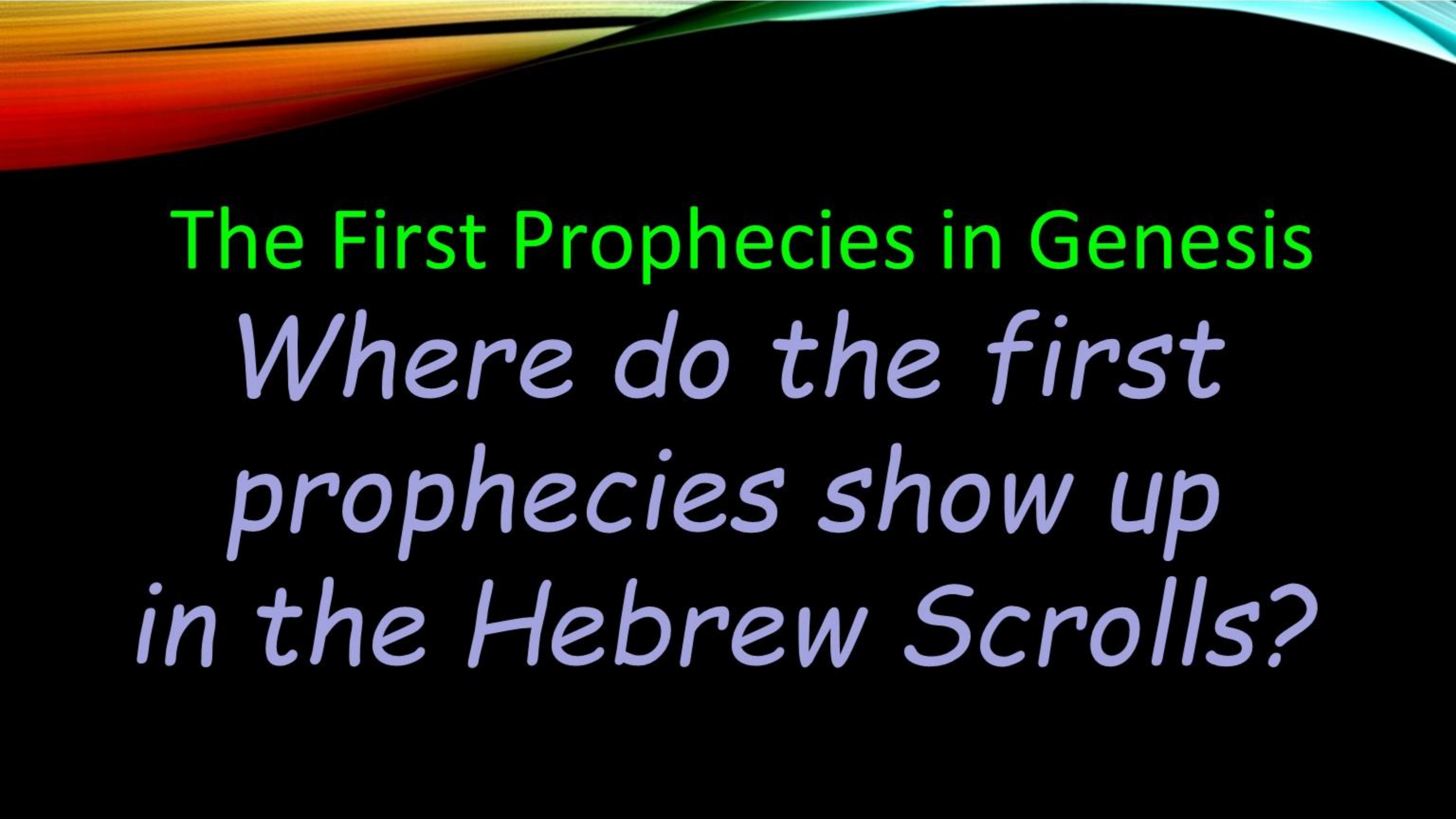




The First Prophecies in Genesis

*Where do the first
prophecies show up
in the Hebrew Scrolls?*

Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

You have heard it said that the first prophecy in the Bible is in Genesis 3:15.

Yahweh, Elohim, said to the serpent, *“Because you have done this, you are cursed more than all livestock and wild animals . . . I will put animosity between you and the woman, and between your descendant and her descendant; he will bruise your head, and you will bruise his heel.”*

But . . . Is that the **first** prophecy?

- What about Genesis 2:17?

Yahweh, Elohim, gave the person this order: *“You may freely eat from every tree in the garden ¹⁷ except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. You are not to eat from it, because on the day that you eat from it, it will become certain that you will die.”*

Let's take a look!!

Isaiah 46:10

I am God, and there is none like me, who announces the *end*^{H319} from the *beginning*^{H7225} and reveals beforehand what has not yet occurred.

H319 achariyth (ach-ar-eeth') [אַחֲרִית']

1. the last or end.

H7225 re'shiyth (ray-sheeth') [רֵאשִׁית]

1. the first, in place, time, order or rank.

2. (*specifically*) a firstfruit.

Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

Isaiah 46:9-10 – Yahweh declares – “*I am Elohim, and there is none like me. At the **beginning** [H7225 רֵאשִׁית re'shiyth] I announce the **end** [H319 אַחֲרִית achariyth], I proclaim in advance things not yet done; and I say that my plan will hold, I will do everything I please to do*”.

Yahweh declares that prophecy starts at the beginning^{H7225}, so we should find prophecy right from the very first verse in the Bible, not three chapters later – and indeed we do – starting with the very first word: B're'shiyth!!

Let's take a look!!

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning^{H7225} God created the heavens and the earth.

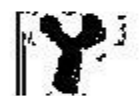
H7225 re'shiyth (ray-sheeth') [רִאשִׁית]

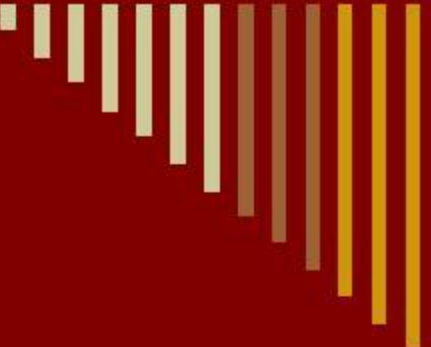

Each of the 22 Hebrew letters are *multi-dimensional*. Each letter in ancient (Paleo) Hebrew has a symbolic representation, so there are words within words.

Below are some of the letters and their symbols, names, and meanings:

Words and Prophecies Found in *Just* the *First* Hebrew Word of the Torah

The first word of the Hebrew Bible is: B're'shiyth. It is pronounced Breh-sheet.

In Hebrew it looks like this: בְּרֵאשִׁית

The first letter, the Bet, means House. The enlarged Bet means this is the story of how Elohim (God) is going to build his house. The second letter, the Resh means head. To start a house (family), the head of the household, a man, takes a bride.

The first two letters combined, Bet and Resh, means Head of Household in Paleo Hebrew. Yeshua is the head of the house of God.

The first three letters form the word "Bara" which means "created". A type of creation that is limited to only God's ability.

Prophecy right from the very first word in the Bible, not three chapters later!

 = House. The enlarged Bet means this is the story of how Elohim (God) is building his house.

In Paleo (ancient) Hebrew it was written like this:  

From the very beginning it has been Elohim's plan to build his house by taking a bride and bringing forth his children.

John 1:1-3: *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made."*

Words and Prophecies Found in *Just* the *First* Hebrew Word of the Torah

The first word of the Hebrew Bible is: B're'shiyth. It is pronounced Breh-sheet.

In Hebrew it looks like this: בְּרֵאשִׁית

B're'shiyth can be (and traditionally is) translated “in the beginning”. The amazing thing about this word in Hebrew is when the letter Bet is used first it can mean either “**In**” or “**For**” or “**By**”. Re'shiyth רֵאשִׁית means first, foremost, or firstfruit. Therefore, it is just as accurate to translate the first word: “for the firstfruit”, or “by the firstfruit!”

Within the first word “In the beginning” we have the phrase “the Head of the Household Created”, the phrase “By and for the Head of Household”, and also the phrase “By and for the firstfruit”!

Prophecy right from the very first word in the Bible, not three chapters later!

בְּרֵאשִׁית

בְּרֵאשִׁית = By and for the first-fruit

רֵאשִׁית = First, foremost, first-fruit

ר = Head

בֶּר = Head of household



From the very "beginning" we see that Elohim gave Yeshua, the one who created all things, to be the first-fruits and head of his household, his creation!

Colossians 1:18: "Yeshua is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might come to have first place in everything."

Words and Prophecies Found in *Just* the *First* Hebrew Word of the Torah

John 1:1-3 – *“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.”*

This is also stated in **Genesis 1:3; Psalm 33:6; Ephesians 3:9; Colossians 1:16; and Hebrews 1:2.**

From the very beginning it has been Elohim’s plan to build his house by taking a bride and bringing forth his children.

**We do not have to wait until Genesis 3:15
for prophecy to begin being revealed!!**

The First Hebrew Word

More Words

Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah

H853 אֶת 'eth [aleph-tav]

= used to point out the object of a verb (indicates that a definite direct object is next, therefore it must come before the heavens and the earth.)

Yeshua is the Aleph-Tav – the direct cause of that which has been created!

H1254 בָּרָא bara

= Son of God, to create (a type of creation that is limited to only God's ability)

Yeshua is the one through whom all things were created!

H7218 רִאשׁ ro'sh

= the first (in many applications, of place, time, rank, etc.)

Yeshua who created all things is the first, or foremost, in all things!

H7217 רִאשׁ re'sh [רִאשִׁי re'sha = my head]

= The head (chief, head, sum)

Yeshua who created all things is head of all things!

Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah

H7225 רִאשִׁית re'shiyth

= the first, in place, time, order or rank, specifically a firstfruit

Yeshua who created all things is the Firstfruits of Creation!

H7896 שִׁיט shiyth

= to place a foundation, a purpose

shiyth preceded by the Alef א means:

= I will lay a foundation

shiyth preceded by the Bet ב means:

= The Son will lay a foundation

Yeshua is the son, the foundation that Yahweh put in place!

H8352 שֵׁט Sheth, or Seth

= Appointed / Substitute

Yeshua is “to be appointed to” death on a tree, and is the substitute who takes Yahweh’s wrath upon himself!

Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah

H7716 שֵׂי sey

= a lamb, a sheep, or a goat

Yeshua is the Lamb of God!

H1274 בְּרִי briy

= fat (as in a well fed animal fattened for sacrifice)

Yeshua is the final sacrifice, found “guilty” by the priests of the temple!

H7897 שִׁית shiyth, or **H7898** שַׁיִת shayith

= to dress, or place on (as in a crown of thorns)

Yeshua who created all things was “dressed” with a crown of thorns!

H1265 בְּרוֹשׁ browsh [normally spelled with a waw בְּרוֹשׁ]

= a cypress tree (convicted criminals were to be hung to death on a tree)

Yeshua who created all things was hung on a tree, a cross!

Words and Prophecies Found in *Just* the *First* Hebrew Word of the Torah

H1285 בְּרִית briyth

= A Covenant

Yeshua is also the one who confirms the Covenant!

H1247 בֶּר bar (corresponds to the Hebrew H1121 בֶּן ben) [see Daniel 3:25]

= a son

Yeshua is the Son of God, and also the Son of Man!

H7862 נִשְׁי shay

= a present, a gift

Yeshua's sacrifice gives us the gift of salvation and eternal life!

H8334 שָׂרַת sharath

= to minister, serve

Yeshua came to serve, not to be served!

Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah

H1004 בַּיִת bayith

= a house, a dwelling habitation, a temple (as in “the Father’s House”)

Yeshua spoke of his body as the Temple. We are now that Temple!

H1250 בָּרָא bar [see Genesis 41:49]

= A grain of any kind (even while standing in the field)

H784 אֵשׁ 'esh

= fire, flames, supernatural fire (figuratively, God’s fire)

H376 אִישׁ ‘iysh

= man, husband, steward, champion

H1323 בַּת bat

= a daughter

*Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah*

- Yeshua is the Aleph-Tav (אָת) – the direct cause of that which has been created!
- Yeshua is the one through whom all things were created (בְּרָא bara)!
- Yeshua who created all things is head (רֹאשׁ ro'sh / re'sh) of all things!
- Yeshua who created all things, is the first, firstfruits, or foremost (רֵאשִׁית re'shiyth) in all things!
- Yeshua is the son (בֶּר bar), the foundation (שִׁיית shiyth) that Yahweh put in place!
- Yeshua was “to be appointed to” (שֶׁת Sheth, or Seth) death (בְּרֵשׁ browsh) on a tree!
- Yeshua is the substitute (שֶׁת Sheth, or Seth) who takes Yahweh’s wrath upon himself!

The first Hebrew word in the Bible is filled with prophecy, indeed!

*Words and Prophecies Found in **Just** the **First** Hebrew Word of the Torah*

- Yeshua is the Lamb of God (שֵׁי sey)!
- Yeshua is the final sacrifice (בְּרִי briy), found “guilty” by the priests of the temple!
- Yeshua was “dressed” (שִׁיִּית shiyth, or שָׁיִיתִית shayithth) with a crown of thorns!
- Yeshua is also the one who confirms the Covenant (בְּרִית briyth)!
- Yeshua is the Son of God (בֶּר אֱלֹהִים Elohim), and also the Son of Man (בֶּן אָדָם adam)!
- Yeshua’s sacrifice gives us the gift (שֵׁי shay) of salvation and eternal life!
- Yeshua came to serve (שָׂרָת sharath), not to be served!
- Yeshua spoke of his body as The Temple (בַּיִת bayith) [We are now that temple]!

The first Hebrew word in the Bible is filled with prophecy, indeed!

John 1:1-3 – *“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.”*

Colossians 1:18: *“Yeshua is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might come to have first place in everything.”*

**From the very beginning it has been Elohim's plan to prophesy what will come to pass.
He did not wait until the third chapter of the Bible to begin revealing those prophecies.**

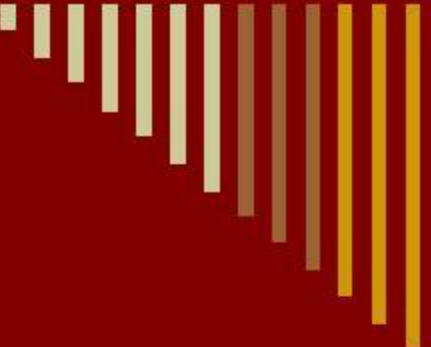
Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

Isaiah 46:9-10 – “I am Elohim, and there is none like me. At the beginning I announce the end, I proclaim in advance things not yet done; and I say that my plan will hold, I will do everything I please to do”.

From the very first word, the Biblical scriptures confirm that:

- Prophecy begins in the first verse of Genesis.
- The first Hebrew word in the Bible, B're'shiyth בְּרֵאשִׁית, is filled with prophecy!
- You do not have to wait until Genesis 3:15 to find the first prophecy.

The First Hebrew Word in the Bible
Is Filled with Prophecy, Indeed!



The First Seven Hebrew Words

*B're'shiyth bara' Elohiym
et ha'shamayim u'et ha'erets*

In Hebrew, the first seven words are written as:

בְּרֵאשִׁית בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים אֶת הַשָּׁמַיִם וְאֶת הָאָרֶץ

And are pronounced

Breh-sheet ba-ra El-oh-heem
et ha-sha-ma-yeem
w-et ha-a-retz

Words and Prophecies Found in the First Four Hebrew Words of the Torah

The first four words of the Torah are: B're'shiyth bara Elohim et. In other words, “In the beginning Elohim created et!”, or “Elohim created the aleph-bet” – from which we get the English word: alphabet. Since Elohim created the Aleph-Tav before he created anything else, the Aleph-Tav is considered to be the primordial building block of all creation.

Et is an untranslatable word, spelled aleph-tav, but is an abbreviation for Yeshua. It indicates that a definite direct object is next, therefore it must come before the heavens and the earth, and indicates who created all: Yeshua, the Aleph-Tav.

Prophetically speaking, if the Aleph-Tav, or Yeshua, were to depart for even an instant, all creation would disappear into absolute nothingness. This is confirmed according to Colossians 1:17 – *“He existed before all things, and he holds everything together,”* and John 1:3 – *“All things came to be through him, and without him nothing made had being,”* just to name two. See also Psalm 33:6; Ephesians 3:9; Colossians 1:16; and Hebrews 1:2.

Yeshua – Creator and Sustainer

If the Aleph-Tav, or Yeshua, were to depart for even an instant, all creation would disappear into absolute nothingness.

Prophetically speaking, this is confirmed according to the scriptures:

Colossians 1:17

– *“He existed before all things, and he holds everything together”*

John 1:3

– *“All things came to be through him, without him nothing made had being”*

See also **Psalm 33:6**; **Ephesians 3:9**; **Colossians 1:16**; and **Hebrews 1:2**.

Words and Prophecies Found in the First Four Hebrew Words of the Torah

The aleph alone has overtones of the “end of days” spoken of in prophecy.

The numerical value of the aleph is 1 or 1,000, and each aleph is said to represent 1 day, or 1,000 years.

There are six alephs in the first verse of the Torah, and this represents the six days of creation, and also the six thousand years of man’s dominion before Yeshua returns to set up His eternal rule.

Remember, “*With the Lord, one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day*” (2 Peter 3:8).

Man's Time of Stewardship

The Six Alephs

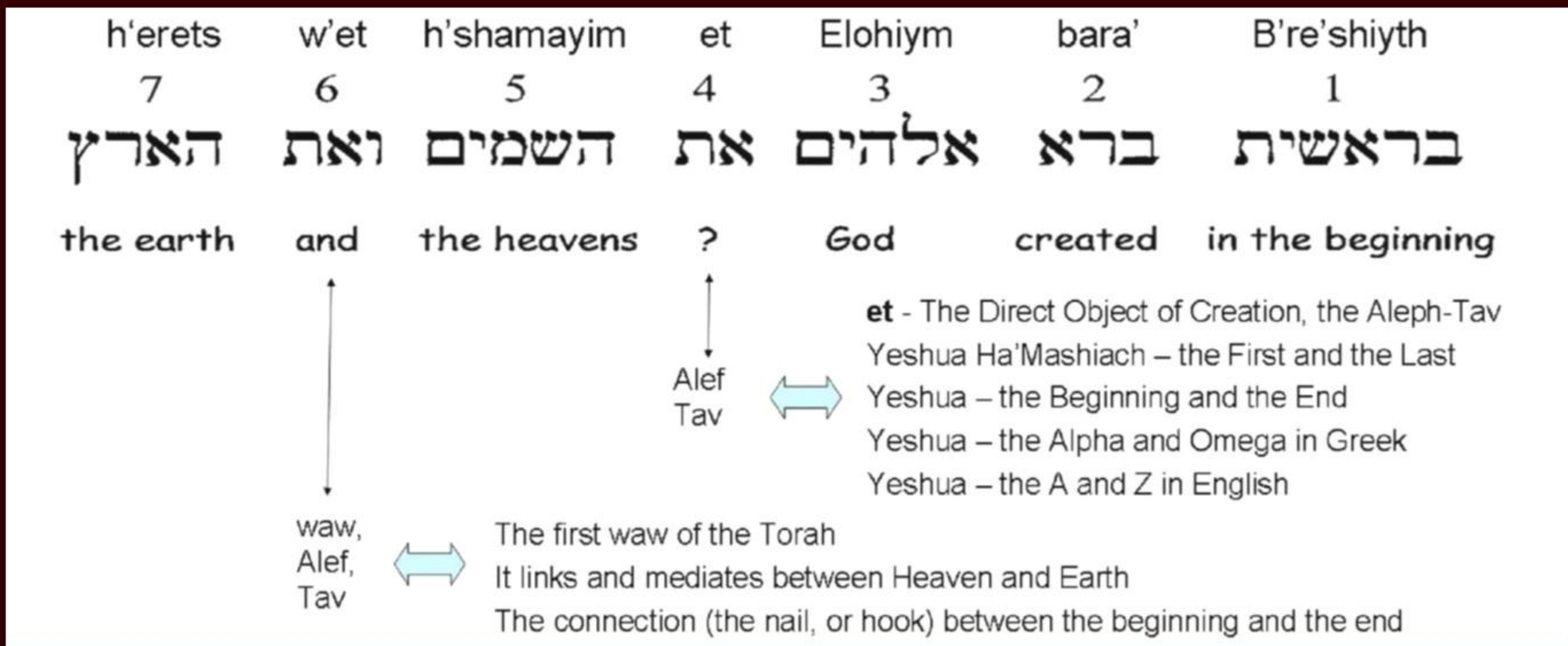
The word Aleph אֵלֶף = 1000

$$6 \times 1000 = 6000$$

2 Peter 3:8 – “Do not ignore this: with the Lord, one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day.”

Each Aleph in the first seven words of Genesis 1:1 represents one day. Man's time of stewardship, therefore, is six-thousand years.

Words and Prophecies Found in the First Seven Hebrew Words of the Torah

In the original Paleo – Hebrew, the Aleph / Tav (et) letters would look like an ox and a cross. We know that Aleph-Tav is a title for Yeshua. This prophecy is confirmed according to [Isaiah 41:4](#); [Isaiah 44:6](#); [Isaiah 48:12](#); and also [Revelation 1:17](#) – “*Don’t be afraid! I am the First and the Last.*” It is also confirmed by [Revelation 1:8](#); [21:6](#); and [22:13](#) – “*I am the Alpha and the Omega.*”

We also know that Yeshua will come twice, as prophesied by the two Aleph-Tavs. The first time Yeshua came is confirmed according to [Romans 5:6](#); and [1 Timothy 2:6](#) – “*At the right time, the Messiah died on behalf of ungodly people.*” That Yeshua will come again a second time is confirmed according to [Matthew 16:27](#); [24:40](#); & [26:64](#); [Mark 13:26](#); & [14:62](#); [Luke 21:27](#); [Acts 1:11](#); and [Revelation 1:7](#) – “*They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven.*”

Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

We know that the Aleph-Tav is a title for Yeshua. This prophecy is confirmed according to Isaiah 41:4; Isaiah 44:6; Isaiah 48:12; and also Revelation 1:17

– *“Don’t be afraid! I am the First and the Last”*

It is also confirmed by Revelation 1:8; Revelation 21:6; and Revelation 22:13

– *“I am the Alpha and the Omega”*

We also know that Yeshua came the first time according to Romans 5:6; and 1 Timothy 2:6

– *“At the right time, the Messiah died on behalf of ungodly people”*

And Yeshua will come again a second time according to **Matthew 16:27; 24:40; & 26:64; Mark 13:26; & 14:62; Luke 21:27; Acts 1:11; and Revelation 1:7**

– *“they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven”*

We do not have to wait until Genesis 3:15 for prophecy to begin being revealed!!

Yeshua – The Aleph-Tav

When we replace the *Aleph-Tavs* with the Paleo-Hebrew symbols, then it looks like this:

Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

When the first seven words are written in the Paleo-Hebrew font, prophecy is revealed. The prophecy states that Yeshua will be hung on a tree (cross) and two others will be hung next to him. And if we replace only the three Tavs then it looks like three crosses! This prophecy is fulfilled according to **Matthew 27:38; Mark 15:27, and Luke 23:33.**

“On execution stakes with Yeshua they placed two robbers, one on his right and one on his left”

We do not have to wait until Genesis 3:15 for prophecy to begin being revealed!!

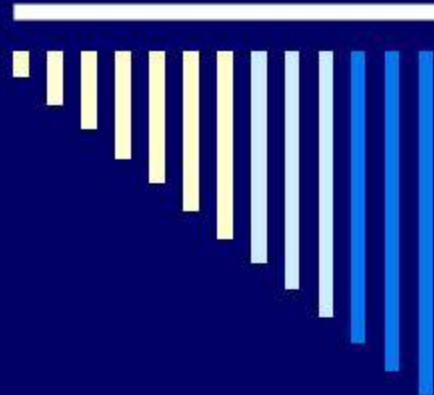
Yeshua's Crucifixion – Three Crosses

When we replace the three Tavs
then it looks like this:

This prophecy of three crosses is fulfilled according to Matthew 27:38, Mark 15:27, and Luke 23:33 – *“On execution stakes with Yeshua they placed two robbers, one on his right and one on his left”*



The Waw, The Broken Waw, Yeshua, and Yahweh

The first use of the letter waw (also known as the vav) in Genesis 1:1 is in the sixth word word, w'et (וְאֵת). It is there that the waw is connected to the second aleph-tav in connection to Yeshua. It refers to the connection between all letters, the connection to the Aleph-Tav who is Yeshua, and is therefore the connecting force of Elohim, the divine “hook” that binds together heaven and earth.

And who does scripture say Yeshua is? 1 Timothy 2:5 tells us “There is one mediator between Yahweh and humankind, between heaven and earth, the man Yeshua Ha’Mashiach”! Hebrews 8:6 confirms this – “But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, by as much as He is also the mediator of a better covenant, which has been enacted on better promises.”

The sixth word in Genesis 1 is w'et – waw aleph tav – the God who is man, and who is pierced by man, who brings a covenant of peace (shalom). This prophecy of shalom can be found in Numbers 25:7-13, in the account of Pinchas, a type or pattern of Yeshua.

The broken waw represents the pierced hand of Messiah nailed to the cross to achieve our peace!

The Waw In The Names

The name Yeshua would have been written in ancient Hebrew. The four letters that make up the name of Yeshua are: Yod, Shin, **Waw**, Ayin [יֵשׁוּעַ H3442]. The letter waw means hook. It can also mean nail. Yeshua was hung on the cross (*three tavs*) using three nails (In other words, *three waws!*)

The four letters that make up the name of Yahweh {YHWH}:

- Yod, Hey, **Waw**, Hey [יְהוָה H3068]

can be translated to mean:

- The Man With The Outstretched Arms and Nailed Hands Shall Be Revealed Twice.
- Behold the Nail, Behold the Hand.
- Behold the Nailed Hand.

The overall meaning of the word, YHWH is: salvation! Therefore, the four letters can also be translated to mean:

- Behold – The Nailed Hand Is Salvation.

*Other Words Found in the **First Seven** Hebrew Words*

H800 אִשְׁשָׁה ishshah or **H801** אִשָּׁה

= My fire, my sacrifice, and is only used in a liturgical sense.
i.e.: A burnt-offering, offering made by fire, a fire offering

My fire, inside the temple, would then be written in the Hebrew as: בְּ אִשְׁתִּי ת

H802 אִשָּׁה 'ishshah

= woman, wife, mate, female

H803 אֲשׁוּיָה 'ashuwyah

= to place a foundation, a purpose

H3050 יָהּ Yah

= Yah, the sacred name. Short for Yahweh

H3820 לֵב leb

= the heart, the feelings, the will, and even the intellect, the center of all

Words and Prophecies Found in the First Seven Hebrew Words of the Torah

- Yeshua is the Aleph-Tav (אָת) – the direct cause of creation (בָּרָא bara)!
- If the Aleph-Tav (אָת), or Yeshua, were to depart for even an instant, all creation would disappear into absolute nothingness.
- The two Aleph-Tav symbols (אָת) prophecy Yeshua's first and second comings.
- The six Aleph symbols (אָת) prophecy 6,000 years of man's time of stewardship.
- The three Tav (ת) symbols prophecy the three crosses found the crucifixion.
- The vav (ו) connected to the Aleph-Tav (אָת) between the Heavens and the Earth is a prophecy of Yeshua, the man who mediates between mankind and God.
- The broken vav (ו) is a prophecy that represents the pierced hand of Messiah nailed to the cross to achieve our peace.

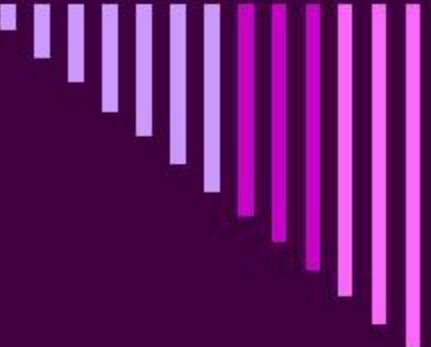
Prophecy Concealed, Prophecy Revealed

Isaiah 46:9-10 – “I am Elohim, and there is none like me. At the beginning I announce the end, I proclaim in advance things not yet done; and I say that my plan will hold, I will do everything I please to do”.

From the very first words, the Biblical scriptures confirm that:

- Prophecy begins in the first verse of Genesis.
- The first seven Hebrew words in the Bible are filled with prophecy, especially the very first word: B're'shiyth בְּרֵאשִׁית!
- You do not have to wait until Genesis 3:15 to find the first prophecy.

The word Aleph אֶלֶף = 1000

$$6 \times 1000 = 6000$$

2 Peter 3:8 – “Do not ignore this: with the Lord, one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day.”

Each Aleph in the first seven words of Genesis 1:1 represents one day. Man's time of stewardship, therefore, is six-thousand years.

This prophecy of three crosses is fulfilled according to **Matthew 27:38**, **Mark 15:27**, and **Luke 23:33** – “*On execution stakes with Yeshua they placed two robbers, one on his right and one on his left*”

Yeshua is the Creator (**Bara** ^{H1254}) of all things

Yeshua is Head (**Rosh** ^{H7218}) of all things

Yeshua is the Stone (**Eben** H68) the builders rejected

אבן

The word for **father** and the word for **son** combine to spell **stone**!

Father אב ['ab H1] **Son** בן [ben H1121]
Stone אבן ['eben H68]

*"Therefore thus says Yahweh Elohim, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a **stone**, a tried **stone**, a precious corner **stone**, a sure foundation."*

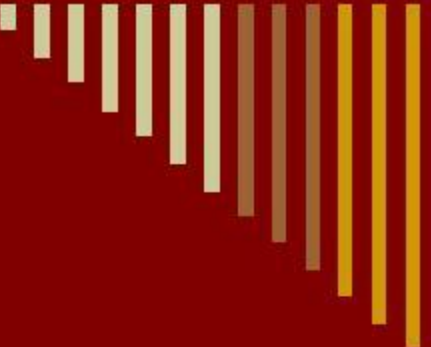

The Aleph-Bet

The Beginning and The End

*The first word of Torah is Be're'shiyt,
And the last word of Torah is Israel.*

ישראל בראשית

*Reading from right to left in the center, are the letters Lamed
Bet. Bet means house and Lamed means leader, or control.*

*Lamed-Bet spells the word leb [H3820 – לֵב] which means the
heart, the feelings, the will, and even the intellect.*

In other words, The heart controls the house.

*The first word of Torah is Be're'shiyt,
And the last word of Torah is Israel.*

Torah is like a necklace, and a necklace needs a clasp.

The Alphabet in Hebrew, like time, is circular.

In the very center is the Mem, Lamed, and Kaf, which spells Melekh, or King
